





• Around 63% of the respondents feel that the Syllabus covers all aspects of contemporary issues of national and international importance.
















Employer Feedback (2021-22)




On the question of **rating of communication skills** of our alumni, 7% of the employer replied in excellent, 66.7% as very good, 26% replied as good.

2. How do you rate the problem solving skills of our alumni. 15 responses














Brief summary about the feedback during the session 2021-22 is as under:

Students have expressed their good level of contentment towards different kinds of techniques and ICT tools incorporated during class. 












7. Do you think online classes were effective during covid period? 2,886 responses





















1. How do you evaluate the syllabus taught to your students. 203 responses




- On the **evaluation of syllabus** 27% teachers responded in excellent, 58% as very good, 9.9% replied good and remaining replied as average.
 - 2. How do you evaluate the internal assessment process of students? $\ensuremath{^{203}\,\text{responses}}$




• For **evaluation of internal assessment** 23.6 % teachers replied in excellent, 59% stated very good, 14.3% responded good while remaining replied as average.


3. How frequently do you identify the strength and weakness of students in mentor-mentee groups? * 203 responses



• On the sufficiency of contact hours for completion of syllabus, 40% replied as absolutely sufficient, 57% as sufficient and remaining replied in neutral.


7. How do you rate the linkage between the syllabus and contemporary global and national scenario.



8. How do you evaluate the linkage between syllabus and employability of students. 202 responses




• On the linkage between syllabus and employability of students, 11.9% replied as excellent, 45.5% replied as very good, 26.7% replied as good and 15% replied as average.
